Rules & Guidelines

At Far East Beach Camping, we encourage all types of campers to have a fun and relaxing time on our beach. To make this possible, here are some guidelines and rules to allow all of our campers to enjoy their stay.

1. We hold the person making the reservation responsible for making sure that their guests follow our rules. Please make sure that you and your fellow campers all **read these rules and guidelines** to avoid any confusion when it comes time for you to pay your bill.
2. **Check-in** is from 5pm-11pm. Guests who arrive after 11pm should expect to carry their own luggage in, as we do not want to disturb sleeping campers. Please let us know if you need to arrange an earlier/later check-in.
3. **Check-out** is at 12pm. Persons who wish to stay longer may do so after paying the day camper's fee. After check-out time, we will not be transporting your luggage back to your car for you, so if you don't wish to carry it, make sure you're packed by 12.
4. We try to make periodic **trash** runs throughout the weekend. You can place your trash in front of your campsite or bring it to the common area and we will dispose of it. If you would like us to pick up trash at any time during the day, just let us know.
5. All of our **running water** is potable water from a well. Hot and cold water can be obtained from our water dispenser, sink, or the hose under the yellow and white tent.
6. Our **slideshow** begins at dusk on Saturday evening, with the movie following. Pictures will also be available online the following Monday. Guests who would rather not have their picture taken or on our website, please let us know.
7. **Quiet time** is from 11:00PM until 6:00AM. During these hours, we ask that you keep noise levels to a minimum, and keep bright lights directed away from your neighbors' tents.
8. **Fires** on the beach must be kept in the fire bowls that we provide at no cost. We collect ashes periodically, and will also do so any time you ask. Persons dumping fires or ashes of any kind will be fined a \$100 clean-up fee per incident, and there will be no warnings or second chances. This is not only a hazard to other campers, but is very difficult to clean up.

9. We will deliver **firewood** to your site upon request with a bowl for your bonfire. A full load is \$20, and a half load is \$15. Pine straw and pinecones found in the forest make great starting material.
10. **Pets** that approach menacingly/bark at guests must be kept on a leash. We reserve the right at any time to ask that guests keep their pets restrained.
11. **Cigarette butts** must be placed either in the trash, or in the receptacles placed throughout the campground. Failure to do so will result in a \$25 fine. We will also bring an ashtray for your site if you wish.
12. Please be aware that **children** are present and refrain from loud profanity/ inappropriate music.
13. Our **solar lights** are placed so campers don't trip over guy lines and other objects at night. If you must borrow one, please put it back or return it to one of our team.
14. Most importantly, **Have Fun** and let us know if there is anything we can do to make your experience more enjoyable. We are never too busy to resolve any issue within our control.
